- Senior excursions and bus excursions have limited spots
- All children going on excursions will be provided a Cottage hat.

Fees and Bookings

- General Rate for VC is \$110 per day
- All vacation care bookings are casual bookings. No recurring/permanent bookings can be made for vacation care days.
- All vacation care bookings are to be placed online via the xap smile app. An admin charge of \$20 will apply to emailed bookings per booking.
- NO REFUND for booking cancellations within 7 days of booking date. E.G. if your child is booked on the Wednesday 17/04 you cannot edit it on and after Wednesday 10/04. The last day you could edit or make a booking for Wednesday 10/04 is Tuesday 09/04. Please keep this in mind.
- Bookings CANNOT be made within 7 days of the booking date via Xap. E.G. if your child is booked on the Wednesday 17/04 you cannot edit it on and after Wednesday 10/04. The last day you could edit or make a booking for Wednesday 10/04 is Tuesday 09/04. Please keep this in mind.
- Bookings within 7 days of the booking date MAY be available if spots are available. These must be made via email and incur a \$20 admin fee.
- No credit is offered for non-attendance or for use on another day or by another child nor will refunds be given for non-attendance.
- \$50 Cancellation Fee Outside of 7 days of Booking Date You will be charged a \$50 fee for cancellations outside of 7 days of booking date. The rest of the booking cost will be added to your account. E.G. \$30 from a early bird booking or \$60 from a regular booking
- \$20 Admin Fee for booking alterations made by Cottage Staff and bookings made within 7 days of the booking date. Must be communicate via email.
- \$10 Excursion Fee The \$10 fee will be added by Cottage staff after the excursion has taken place. If your child did not attend that day, this fee will not be applied to your account.
- New cottage community members enrol well before the start of the holidays to allow time for enrolment acceptance, induction, booking eligibility AND Child-care Subsidy.

Important Information



- SIGN-IN and COLLECTION: use Xap Kiosk in Cottage Foyer to sign in and out your child(ren). You will need your phone number and Kiosk Code found in your Xap account. Enter via Cambridge Street lower gate to Glenmore Road Public School; ring us on 9361 3362 if gate is locked /unattended.
- WHAT YOUR CHILD MUST HAVE EACH DAY: 'closed-in' shoes, a raincoat, a bag containing a water bottle, morning tea and lunch PLUS a jumper/change of clothes and any special sunscreen they may require.
- MEDICATIONS: All medications must be explicitly signed over by Parents to the Operations Supervisor. Please allow time at sign-in to complete our medication authorisation form.
- KEEP YOUR PHONE ON: When your child is with us your phone must be on so that we can contact you at all times.
- PERMISSION FORM: to be collectively signed, available at The Cottage OSHC from Monday 8th April.
- RISK ASSESSMENTS: available for each day upon request
